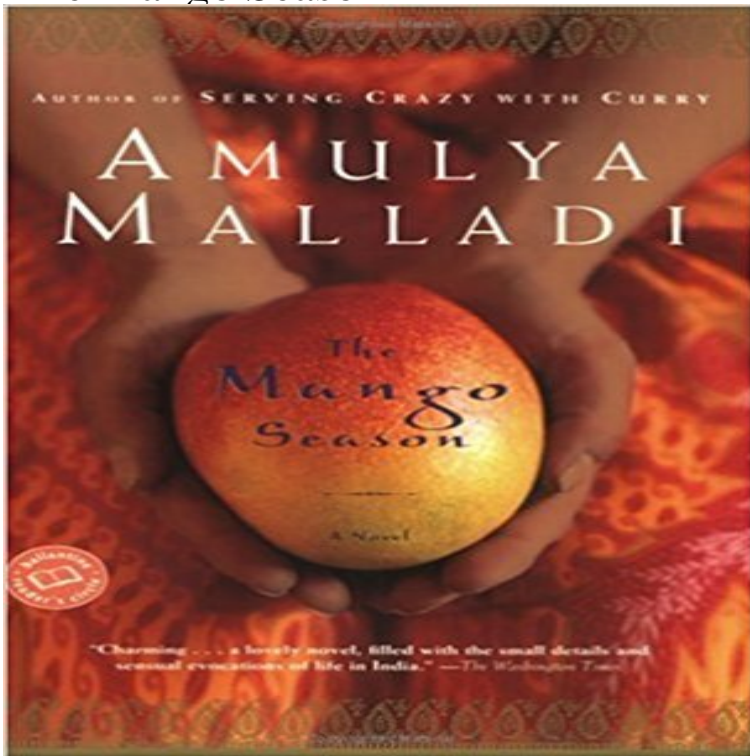


The Mango Season
