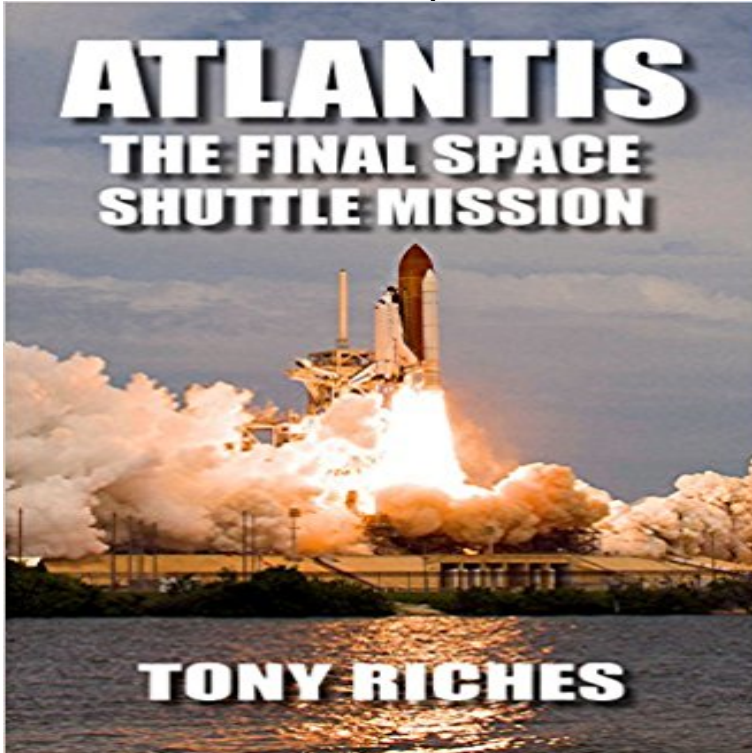


Atlantis - The Final Space Shuttle Mission



In its thirty year career, space shuttle Atlantis covered more miles and completed more missions than any other spacecraft in history. Atlantis touched down on the Shuttle Landing Facility's Runway 15 at 5:57 a.m. EDT on July 21st 2011, bringing to an end 30 years of space shuttle flights. This book is the story of that historic flight, with pictures of every crew member and summaries of all 33 missions flown by Atlantis.
