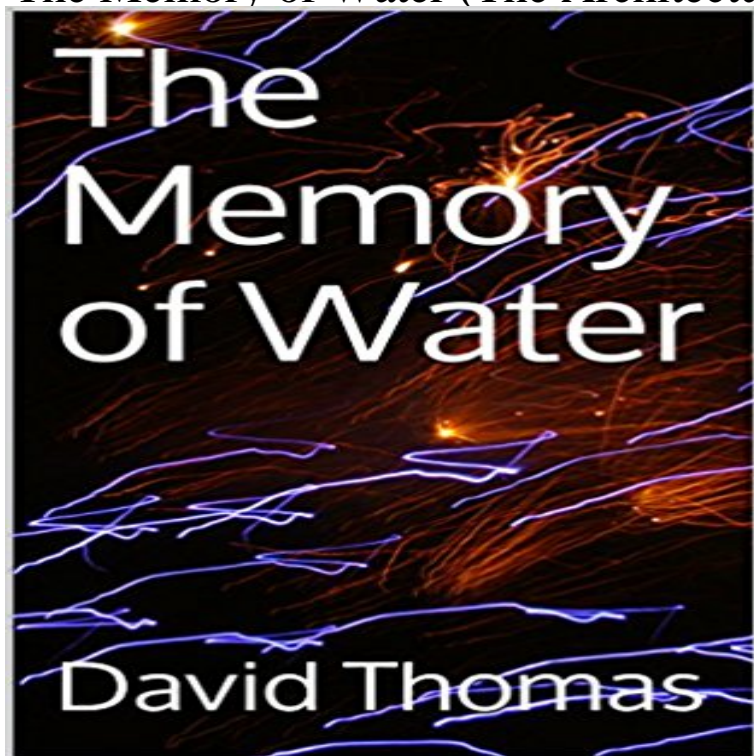


The Memory of Water (The Architecture of Sleep Book 1)
