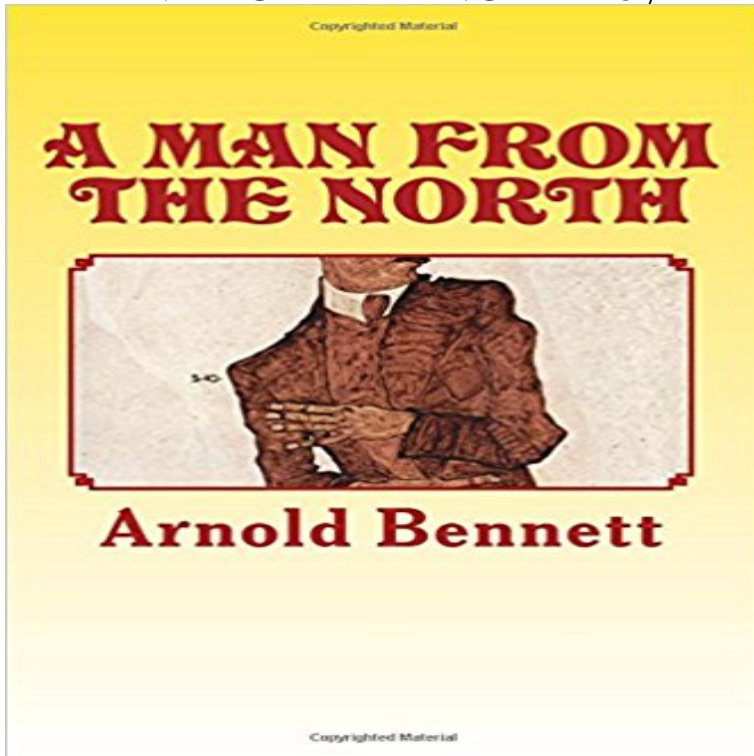


A MAN FROM THE NORTH by ARNOLD BENNETT: New Edition
