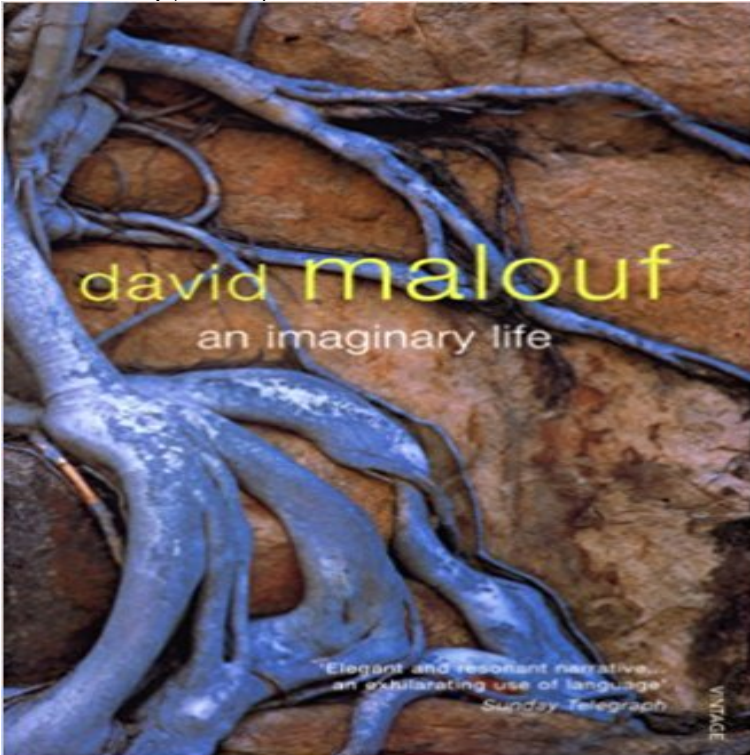


An Imaginary Life
