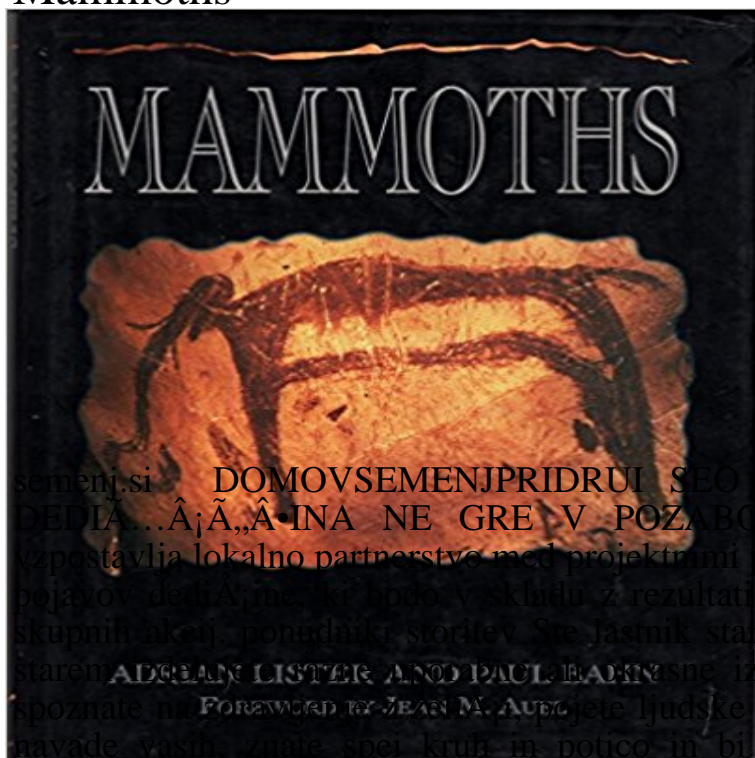


Mammoths
